**STATE CAPTURE COMMISSION REFERENCE: 31/1/SCC/497**

We have not met. You called me at 12h13 on 28 November 2019 from cellphone number: xxx xxx 0759. We spoke for about six minutes after I returned your call. You indicated to me that you were investigating our submission to the State Capture Commission. You referred to our call for the recusal of Advocate Vincent Maleka, who was Chairman of the Gauteng Gambling Board at the time of the award of the Gold Reef City Casino License.

I told you that our first affidavit, requesting an opportunity to be heard at the State Capture Commission is dated over a ago (about July 2018) You seemed surprised. We mention this only because the "*Maleka Affidavit*" is, in many respects, a supplementary affidavit. It is inextricably linked to our first affidavit requesting an opportunity to be heard before Commission.

You told me that Maleka's term at the Commission had come to an end and asked whether we still wanted to pursue our application for his recusal. I told you that I am not trained in the science of law and that I would have to consider how such a decision could impact on the fullness of our allegations into State Capture. We concluded our conversation with your undertaking to contact me via email today, 02 December 2019. You promised to provide insight into why, given your legal experience, the recusal of Maleka may now be rendered obsolete.

This email seeks only to record my understanding of our discussion. Please do not hesitate to correct me.
